Prayer 4: Landing

If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you. But when you ask, you must believe and not doubt, because the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind. know.

James 1:5-6 NIV

The most difficult necessary part of flying is landing. The pilot must control the rate of descent and the speed of the aircraft so that the plane passes through the narrow window of safe landing limits. The most difficult thing about prayer in a similar way is praying according to the Father's will so that our desires match his and our requests are in line with his will, reinforced by our faith in him to deliver.

Sometimes the way ahead is so clear that we know from the Spirit witnessing with our spirit exactly what to ask. At other times, being honest, we struggle to determine whether our desires match those of the Father. The implication may be that we have to wrestle for some time to know exactly what to ask before we receive assurance concerning our request. However, to help us, God is able to provide us with the wisdom we need if we ask for it (James 1:5) and is able to assist us as we pray if we allow him (Rom 8:26). At those times, how many of us though, are prepared to be patient enough in our instant consumer society to wait long enough on God to determine what we should ask.
